This summer Gwynedd Archaeological Trust is looking to recruit volunteers to help with our work at Pen y Bryn Quarry Barracks, Dyffryn Nantlle.

The site comprises a block of four barracks and other associated features which were converted from a seventeenth-century building during the 1860s. This project will aim to provide a clearer understanding of the phasing and development of the barracks. Excavation will aim to provide evidence of the activities carried out here and provide evidence of the material culture of quarrymen and their families.
